Within 5 days of receipt in the laboratory you will receive full results including error limits enabling early corrective action if this should be necessary.

We recommend a Solder Bath Analysis to be taken every 3-6 month period for Tin-Lead and Lead-Free applications. After initial filling during the first 6 month same period as mentioned above need to be applied.

Sampling

Sampling technique may influence the results of the analysis and how these relate to your solder bath. Sensible precautions are summarized below.

- The solder bath must be at minimum operating temperature.
- The solder bath must be well mixed. It is best to sample from a running wave just before the end of production.
- For sampling use a clean and preheated steel spoon. Samples must always be formed in a cold mould.
- The solder bath test must the dimensions indicated here. We reserve the right to charge for reworking of alloy samples if this is necessary.
